Free car parking is available at the hotel with an overflow car park across the road in the main reserve car park.


## About Port Lympe

Set over 600 acres, Port Lympe is home to the UK's most authentic safari experience. There are over 700 rare and endangered animals at Port Lympe, including the largest herd of black rhino in the UK, western lowland gorillas, the only giraffe in Kent, tigers, lions, leopards, bears and so much more.
