**HAMPSHIRE TOURISM BUSINESS CELEBRATE WINS
AT NATIONAL INDUSTRY AWARDS**

Three Hampshire tourism businesses scooped Awards at today's Enjoy England National Awards for Excellence held at The Great Hall in Birmingham. Overall, four gold and two silver Awards were presented to South Eastern businesses, making it a record award-winning year for the region.

Winchester Tourism Information Centre carried off gold for Tourist Information Service whilst silver Awards went to Chewton Glen Hotel in New Milton (Large Hotel of the Year) and Tylney Hall Hotel in Rotherwick (Outstanding Customer Service). Other golden South East winners were The Bay Tree Hotel (Small Hotel of the Year) and Royal Ascot (Best Tourism Event).

Organised by VisitEngland, the annual Awards recognise outstanding commitment to customer service and high quality standards in 15 categories. Four gold Awards and two silver Awards in this celebration of the *crème de la crème* of the UK's tourism businesses represents the best-ever winning haul for the South East and proves once again that the region can lead the country in providing a world-class visitor experience.

'We had six finalists in some of the most competitive and high-profile categories of these prestigious national awards which is in itself an achievement. To win four gold and two silver Awards shows that the South East's destinations, accommodation and attractions offer outstanding service, experiences and value and set the gold standard not just in England but internationally', commented John Williams, Chairman, Tourism South East.
